### Construction Completes on Oviedo Fire Station No. 48

Longwood, Fla. (February 18, 2009) – A ribbon cutting ceremony was held on January 31 to celebrate the completion of the City of Oviedo's new Fire Station No. 48 at 1930 W. CR 419. The new state-of-the-art fire station is 6,533 square feet and contains three drive-thru apparatus bays, bunk rooms, a day room, a fitness area, and a kitchen. The new facility will replace the temporary trailer facility that the firefighters at Station 48 have been using for years.

At the same location, a fire administration building, also designed by Bentley Architects + Engineers, Inc., is being constructed and is expected to complete in April. M.W. Mitchell Construction & Development Inc. is the contractor on both buildings.
