Construction Begins on City of Kissimmee Fire Station No. 11

Longwood, Fla. (August 20, 2009) – Construction has started on the City of Kissimmee’s newest fire station, Station 11, located at 343 North Clyde Avenue in Kissimmee. This is the City’s first LEED® project planned for certification.

Bentley Architects + Engineers, Inc. provided Architectural, Land Development and Structural Engineering design services for the 16,300 square foot station. Wharton Smith of Orlando is the contractor. Completion is expected in June of 2010.

The new station will house 12 fire fighters, and includes a workout room, four apparatus bays, sleeping quarters, kitchen and administrative offices. The various green features incorporated into the facility will reduce the operating costs over the lifetime of the facility.
