### Bentley Team Awarded Turnpike Electronic Toll Conversion Project

**Longwood, Fla. (August 28, 2009)** – As part of Kiewit Southern Co. and Gannett Fleming, Inc.'s design-build team, Bentley was awarded a portion of work for Phase 3 of the electronic toll conversion project along the Homestead Extension of Florida's Turnpike in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties. This project will upgrade current toll plazas to include dedicated high-speed electronic tolling lanes at 21 locations.

The project is valued at \$24.7 million and design is schedule to commence on October 8, 2009. Bentley's scope includes gantry design for tolling equipment at 21 tolling locations, as well as civil engineering and architectural renovations for upgrades at 18 toll facility administration buildings.
